As a result of the financial failure of Northamptonshire County Council, the Government has decided that all councils in the county should be abolished and replaced with a number of unitary authorities.

A likely outcome will be that Daventry, South Northamptonshire and Northampton will become a single authority. This would result in many decisions affecting Daventry being taken in Northampton, an increase in council tax, reductions in staff and the services they provide, and a weakening of our local democracy.
